CURRICULUM

KEY STAGE 3

Key Stage 3 covers the first three years of secondary education (classes 1,2 and 3) and is devised as a foundation course for Key Stage 4 (GCSE/IGSE) study.

THE CORE CURRICULUM (COMPULSORY FOR ALL STUDENTS) IS AS FOLLOWS:

Art, Drama, English, French, Geography, Greek/Special Greek, History, Information Communication Technology, Mathematics, Music, Physical Education, Religious Education, Science, Personal and Social Education.

KEY STAGE 4

Key Stage 4 covers classes 4 and 5 and prepares students for the GCSE/IGCSE examinations. All students study a core curriculum, ICT (Information Communication Technology), Science (Double Award) and Mathematics with the addition of Physical Education. This is supported by choices from a wide range of options, which include all of the Key Stage 3 subjects with the addition to Russian, Accounting, Economics and Psychology. At the end of class 5 students sit for external GCSE/IGCSE examinations in up to 9 subjects.

POST SIXTEEN EDUCATION

Covers classes 6 and 7 (years 11+12) and prepares students for GCE Advanced Subsidiary and Advance Level Examinations (AS and A2 examinations).

COMPULSORY SUBJECTS: English, Personal and Social Education, Physical Education.

OPTIONAL SUBJECTS- STUDENTS CHOOSE FROM THE LIST BELOW:

(8 periods per subject) Art, Accounting, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Drama, Economics, English Literature, Italian, French, History, Information Communication Technology, Mathematics, Music, Physical Education, Physics and Psychology is offered after school.

Every effort is always made to offer as board range of subjects as possible for the Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 Curriculum, and students are helped to make informed and balanced choices. Furthermore, a full-time careers advisor is available for careers guidance as well as a full-time counselor providing personal counseling and guidance to our students.

The school is an approved examination center for the GCSE/IGCSE and GCE AS and A2 Level examinations which are administered from the UK and are recognized internationally.



ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING

Assessment improves a student's performance by highlighting strengths and weakness enabling appropriate strategies to be used by both teachers and students. Assessment at the American Academy Limassol takes the form of written tests, homework, classwork, course work and class participation as well as formal examinations. Reporting upon progress and the results of assessment form a significant part of school/parent communication and is fundamental to the learning process. Adequate and regular feedback enables students to develop a satisfactory awareness of their skills and capabilities and keeps parents informed of their child's progress.

Formal Reporting takes the form of face-to-face regular interviews and written reports issued thought the year. In addition, a Parents' Visit Schedule is issued in September indicating when teachers are available to see parents throughout the year.

The school curriculum is an entitlement for all students and special arrangements are made for students with specific learning difficulties. Cases are considered individually after referral to the Learning Support Center and in consultation with the educational psychologist.



THE AA PRIVATE INSTITUTE

Our teacher are experienced educators with the majority of them boasting expertise in more than one language. The teaching environment is relaxed and friendly. With continuous contact between management and parents, ensuring ongoing collaboration. The progress of each child is monitored and progress reports are prepared every term.

Tutoring is between 2.00 pm to 7.00pm and each lesson lasts one hour. Students attend lessons at least twice a week. A bus service is available.

The American Academy Institute has been operating successfully as a Foreign Language Center since 1986, offering quality learning to students of all age and backgrounds. The Institute's high standards, the modern teaching methods, the small number of students in each class and the competence of our teaching staff offer excellent examination results every year.

The Institute also offers special "Homework Classes" that cater to the needs of elementary school pupils experiencing difficulties doing their homework on their own at home. The children are taught how to study effectively and productively and how to focus properly in order to enhance their concentration. This eventually leads to autonomy where the children are able to overcome any potential difficulties in any subject when completing their school work at home.



LEARNING SUPPORT CENTER

GENERAL INFORMATION

The American Academy operates a Greek and English speaking Learning Support Center that offers highly specialized help to children with dyslexia and other learning difficulties in the areas of reading, spelling, writing, reading, reading comprehension and mathematics.

All teaching staff are university graduates, experienced and specially trained in helping children with various special education needs. The environment is relaxed and friendly and both the management and parents are in close contact which ensures cooperation on both sides.

The Learning Support Center of the American Academy organizes lectures, with experts on dyslexia from both Cyprus and abroad, for parents and the public in order to increase general awareness concerning the existence and problems related to dyslexia. These lectures aim to help parents identify their children's learning potential problems and seek specialized help in time.

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION/TEACHING METHODS

The teaching method is based on one-to-one tuition or on groups of not more than four. Tuition uses a multi-sensory approach to improve reading, spelling, writing and mathematics. Various resources are used such as books, multi-sensory teaching aids and software. Through structured exercises children are helped to overcome their difficulties and learn at their own pace. Tuition is provided for the ages 5-15.

The teaching focuses on the difficulties revealed in the initial assessment and the teaching programmes are tailored to individual needs. The progress of each child is followed up monitored by an Educational Psychologist and progress reports are prepared and given to parents every term.

Tutoring is between 2.00pm to 7.00pm and each lesson lasts for one hour. Students attend lessons at least three times per week.





BOARDING HOUSE AMERICAN ACADEMY LIMASSOL

American Academy Limassol offers boarding accommodation within close proximity to the school, which enables students to make full use of the school facilities during the day and on weekends. The students reside in a comfortable, safe and clean environment and are monitored by experienced staff on a twenty-four-hour basis.

The boarders are allocated a personal tutor who closely monitors the students' academic progress and keeps their parents/guardians regularly informed. Outside school hours various social and leisure activities are arranged on a weekly basis.

The American Academy International Summer School is and academic learning center within an international context and a forum for fostering intercultural understanding for students ages twelve to eighteen. Every summer in July we welcome students from all over the world, offering them the opportunity to combine study with an unforgettable experience.

The Educational Programme offered is dedicated to the improvement of the English Language and is led by experienced teachers who have graduated from top Universities in England and the United States of America. The programme is designed to match the student's individual needs, therefore class placement depends on the level of the students' English language. In addition, have a wide range of Extra Curricular Activities lead by experienced instructors.

Moreover, weekend excursions give the students an insight into the rich culture and history of Cyprus with visits to archeological sites such as: Kykkos Monastery, Tomb of the Kings, Cyprus Mosaics and the Kourion Ancient Theater. Entertaining excursions include a catamaran sea trip, an aqua park visit, a night sea trip to Paphos Aquarium.

Accommodation is provided either in a hotel or in hotel apartments with fully air-conditioned rooms with a private swimming pool. The American Academy Summer School Certificate of Achievement is awarded to all students passing the final examination.
